6 RANGE

This is a family car for all the family, even though each member may want quite a different kind of car to the other. There are two versions — the 6L and 6TL. Both offer saloon car comfort and styling, with ample breathing space for four large adults or a party-load of children. They offer estate car versatility with easy loading of up to 42 cubic feet of cargo through a fifth door. They can cruise smoothly all day at motorway speeds, or can nip equally happily around town, parking in surprisingly small spaces.

But, above all, the Renault 6 will endear itself to the member of the family who foots the bills. 35-40 mpg may be pleasing enough, but there's more to economy than low petrol consumption. Renault have a reputation for making a range of cars with remarkably low running costs. This has been earned not just by the design of the cars themselves, but by a very efficient After Sales Service offered by a countrywide network of dealers. Each has factory-trained staff, uses the right servicing equipment and carries a comprehensive range of parts, backed up, if necessary, by the Renault 48-hour Parts Delivery Service. A full diagnostic service is only required at intervals of 6-9,000 miles or once a year.

6TL

An 1108 cc engine gives the Renault 6TL a top speed of over eighty. It has a sealed cooling system with electric radiator fan and an alternator charges the battery. 35–40 mpg overall can be expected.

Front-wheel drive, rack and pinion steering, all-round independent suspension and radial-ply tyres all contribute to its positive handling and stable road holding.

The 4-speed all-synchromesh gearbox is operated smoothly in the conventional 'H' pattern by a dashboard-mounted lever.

Brakes are disc and drum with a pressure limiter to prevent premature locking when only lightly laden.

On the right of the steering column are the three-position lighting stalk, horn and headlight flasher and self-cancelling direction indicators. On the left are the ignition switch and an anti-theft steering lock. The instrument panel contains the speedometer, mileage recorder, fuel gauge, voltmeter and warning lights for water temperature/oil pressure, main beam and direction indicators. To the right are the fingertip stalk control for the two-speed windscreen wipers and electric washers and rocker switches for the two-speed booster fan, the heated rear window and the hazard warning lights. To the left are the heater and ventilation controls. There is a glovebox with magnetic catch and next to it an ashtray. Below is a wide parcel shelf for both driver and passenger.

Other features are a day/night driving mirror, a door-mounted exterior mirror, a courtesy light and padded sun visors with passenger vanity mirror.







The whole family will appreciate the soft padded seats, which support each part of the body correctly according to medical experts, and harmonize with the suspension to smooth out vibrations. Covering is in soft vinyl, while cloth (as illustrated) is optional extra. The front seats are reclining and adjustable for leg room on ball-bearing runners.


With four wide-opening doors and no transmission tunnel, four large adults can be carried with ample head, leg and elbow room for comfort. Children can be safely contained with childproof rear door locks.

The powerful electric booster fan on the heater/demister copes with extreme hot or cold conditions. Adjustable vents in the dashboard can provide large amounts of additional fresh air, and a heated rear window is fitted as standard.

The Renault 6TL has been designed not just to be polished and admired as it stands in the driveway, but to be used and appreciated by all members of the family, whether as drivers or as passengers. And it will uncomplainingly take the sort of rough treatment families can hand out.










This has the same basic Renault 6 qualities as the TL. It has the same robust box frame chassis, all-round independent torsion-bar suspension and 4-speed fully synchromesh gearbox. It has five doors and the same capacity for people and luggage.

The front seats have fixed backrests, but they all have the same soft comfort. The 6L also has an impressive list of equipment, including electrically operated windscreen washers with two-speed

wipers, heater/demister with electric booster fan and independent fresh-air ventilation.

Other well-thought-out features shared with the TL include flush interior door handles, interior safety padding and excellent all-round vision.

There are minor styling and trim differences from the TL and, of course, a different engine – the well-proven 34 bhp (DIN) 845 cc unit, which combines lively performance with exceptional economy.

6L/TL

A wide counter-balanced tailgate gives access to the boot down to floor level for easy loading.

By folding down the handy rear parcel shelf, the 12 cubic foot boot can be further extended in height and can even accommodate a large family dog.

By releasing catches at either side of the parcel shelf, however, you can fold the rear seats away to give estate car capacity of up to 42 cubic feet for bulky loads. When heavily laden, the headlights can be adjusted for height at the flick of a switch. The brakes have a pressure limiter in the rear which operates according to the load carried, while high ground clearance and all-round independent torsion bar suspension ease you over the bumps.

Thus, the Renault 6 can adopt any role your family demands of it – saloon car, estate car, economy car – and at 35–40 mpg you can afford to make full use of it.




